About Holy Trinity Greek School: Holy Trinity Greek School is the forerunner in Greek education in Phoenix, Arizona. The school operates under the auspices of the Greek Consulate of Los Angeles and the Greek Archdiocese of the United States. Its high-quality instructors have backgrounds in elementary or second-language education.

About the Curriculum: Holy Trinity Greek School's Children's program provides a foundation in Greek grammar, vocabulary, reading, listening, and speaking, while also introducing children of Greek and other cultural backgrounds to Greek history, customs, and culture, as well as Greek Orthodox Heritage.

Levels: Because we believe that language learning should be conducted according to ability rather than age and that learning should never be rushed, we offer the following series of class levels:

Beginner: For Preschool and Kindergarten age students beginning Greek.

Level 1: For students who completed Beginner class or who are 1st grade or above and just beginning Greek.

Level 2: Basic Greek grammar, vocabulary building, and solidification of reading skills. For students who completed Level 1 and who are 1st grade or above.

Level 3: Intermediate Greek grammar, continued vocabulary building, basic written expression. For students who completed Level 1 and 2 and who are 3rd grade or above.

Certificate Preparation: Certificate preparation offered for foreign language credit. The certificate test is usually taken when student reaches age 12 and is administered by the Greek Ministry of Education.

Day and Time: Friday evenings, September 2, 2011 through May 11, 2011, 5:00 – 7:00 pm.

Where: Holy Trinity Greek Orthodox Cathedral, 1973 East Maryland Avenue, Phoenix, AZ 85016-1498.

Tuition and Books: \$330 per student annually (\$165 per semester). There is a \$30 annual discount offered for registering additional children in a family after the first. A **\$30 non-refundable book fee** is included in the annual tuition, and students keep their books at year's end.

Registration: To register please complete a Registration Form (available on www.holytrinityphx.org) and mail it to the Holy Trinity address above. Tuition payment is due on or before the first day of class. A full tuition refund will only be given before 9/30/2011.
